## God's Providence

Today's readings celebrate God's providence. No matter how wonderful (or heartbreaking) our relationships are, God always provides for us. No one cares for us the way God does.



Isaiah delights us with a deeply intimate image of God caring for us "as a mother comforts her child." The prophet describes us not as the usual "children of God," but as "babies." We should not resist this image, but rejoice in it. Trusting in God's care, we can all let down our guard and rest like infants in the lap of our mother.

Saint Paul's trust in God allows him to be at peace like this. He boldly declares that no one can "make troubles" for him, because he has given himself completely to Jesus. ## Saint of the Week

***St. Benedict, July 11;***

(c. 480-547)- Born in Italy, Benedict became a monk at Subiaco and lived in a cave. He attracted followers and built small monasteries for those wishing to share his lifestyle. He and a few companions founded the monastery of Monte Cassino, where he wrote his Rule, a remarkable guide emphasizing moderation, humility, obedience, prayer and manual labor as the way to holiness. Considered the Patriarch of monasticism, he was proclaimed Patron of Europe in 1964. *(Living with Christ, July 2019)*
