the Pharisees in today's Gospel, they have places of honor wherever they go. Would you like to follow their footsteps?

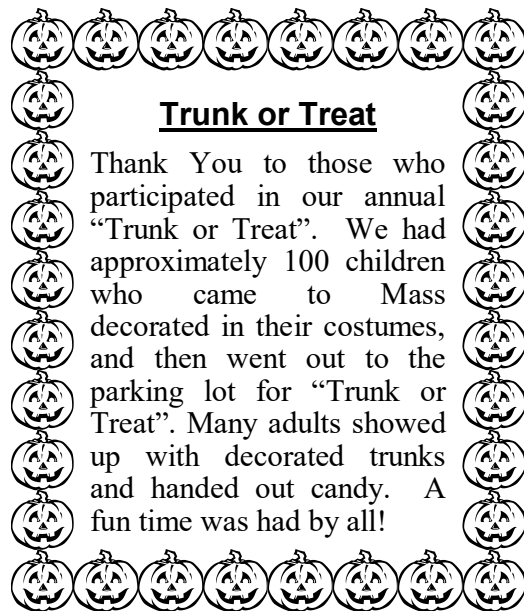
