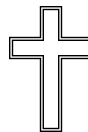


Last Chance for Green Beans

Men's Club News

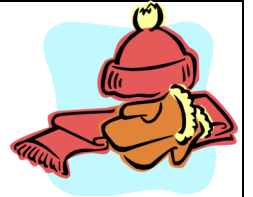
